We may have more opportunities to see the Northern Lights over the next year or so, as the "seem" to appear more frequently during sunspot minimums.

## **Latest News On Amateur Radio Parity Act**

There actually is some news for a change! The Amateur Radio Parity Act was introduced on 07/12 to the US Senate as bill S-1534, which is identical to House bill H-555, approved back in January. The Senate will begin their summer recess shortly, so we'll have to wait and see what the agenda looks like when they come back. In order to "stimulate interest" among Senators, the ARRL has created a "Rally Congress" web page (link below). If you go to the site, you can send an e-mail to the Senators from your state. ## The 2017 Solar Eclipse Final Reminder

This is a VERY big deal! This will be the first solar eclipse that has swept across the continental United States since 1918. While the "total coverage" only affects a strip about 70

miles in width, everyone reading this newsletter will experience "partial coverage". The eclipse event will take place on Monday 08/21/17. (The simulator in the second link shows the impact of the eclipse on your location, including the amount of "coverage" and the time of most "darkening". Works for any city name or zip code in the US, regret it does not work for Canadian locations).
