As all hams will recall, the old rule was that a ham radio tower can be up to 200 feet tall with no lighting or special painting, unless you are in the glide path of an airport. The new rules will be slightly different, but you do not have to register your tower with the FAA if you live in a city or town; if you live in the country but the tower is near your house or barn; if your tower is less than 50 feet tall. You might have to register with the FAA if your situation is different. The new rules are still being ironed out, and the registration procedure is still under development. We'll try to keep you posted as new news appears.
